- I. The Commission approved the minutes of the January 2, 2020 meeting.
- II. The Commission reviewed and considered a referral from the Rules Committee of the Superior Court regarding a request from Attorney Jonathan Weiner, chair, CBA Civics Education Committee, to amend Practice Book §2-27A(b)(7) expanding the MCLE rule permitting up to 4 hours per year of MCLE credit for judging or coaching mock trials and moot court to include “scholastic and collegiate” competitions. Memorandum from First Assistant Bar Counsel Elizabeth M. Rowe. The MCLE Commission considered the request and did not support a rule change to include non-law school moot court competitions.
