- 4. The Committee considered revised proposals to Article V—Privileges, which were presented by Judge Jongbloed and Attorney Wiechmann. The subcommittee will receive comments by Judge Prescott for further consideration and revision.
- 5. Judge Bishop thereafter discussed the timeline for submitting the Code to the Supreme Court and drafting the transmittal letter. He also discussed the proposed agenda for the next meeting.
- 6. After discussion, the next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, 2017, in the Supreme Court courtroom at 2:00 p.m.
