- I. The meeting started at 3:07 p.m.
- II. Judge Devlin introduced two new members to the committee, Paul Hartan and Gary Roberge.

- IV. Judge Handy provided an update on planning this year's *Journalism School for Judges*.
- V. The committee discussed whether cameras should be allowed in cases where a victim had been sexually assaulted and murdered. Court rules do not allow photos or video of court proceedings where the victim of a sexual assault was killed. However, Hartford Courant Editor John Ferraro asked at the September 2016 meeting whether a judge has the discretion to allow cameras in those proceedings where a victim of a sexual assault was killed. To assist further discussion at this meeting, committee members had for their reference a list of how other states handles similar circumstances.
