- a) An agency providing PEP turned away a client on a particular day because they had a fee waiver. The client was offered another day but it was inconvenient.
- b) Attempts were made to speak directly to the person who was impacted but they did not return the calls placed to her.
- c) All the other agencies providing PEP were contacted and the issue was discussed.
- d) The agency that turned away the client was told they need to be more responsive to their clients' needs.

3) Decision on RFP for PEP

- a) A one year extension will be used.
- b) What is going rate of psycho-educational group?
- c) Discussions regarding fee waivers need to occur.
 - 1) Might be simpler to not use sliding scale but to keep it either at \$125or free.

 - b) Individuals are inquiring about becoming PEP providers.
