

The <u>Connecticut Supreme Court</u> will start the first term of the 2016-17 court year on Monday, Sept. 12, when it is scheduled to hear arguments in two cases. The first term will end on Friday, Sept. 23. All cases argued this term will occur at the <u>Supreme Court courtroom</u>, 231 <u>Capitol</u> Ave., Hartford.
