Restraining Orders (§ 46b-15) and Civil Protection Orders (§ 46b-16a)

Calendar Year 2022

## March 10, 2023

Pursuant to CGS § 46b-15e(b), the Judicial Branch prepared the following report that contains restraining and protection order information for calendar year 2022:

46b-15e(b): The Chief Court Administrator shall annually collect data on (1) the number of restraining orders issued under section 46b-15 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, and civil protection orders issued under section 46b-16a of the general statutes, as amended by this act; (2) the number of such orders that are not picked up by an applicant from the office of the clerk at the court location which issued the order; (3) the method of service of such orders in cases in which a respondent is successfully served with the order; (4) the number of requests for a police officer to be present at the time service of an order pursuant to subsection (h) of section 46b-15 of the general statutes, as amended by this act; and (5) the number of such orders issued that subsequently expire or are dismissed because the respondent could not be served with the order.
