The mere fact of treatment for mental health problems or chemical or psychological dependency is not, in and of itself, a basis on which an applicant is ordinarily denied admission to the Connecticut bar. As with applications for admission to the bar, the Connecticut Bar Examining Committee anticipates that it will regularly recommend licensing of individuals who have demonstrated personal responsibility and maturity in dealing with mental health and chemical or psychological dependency issues. The Committee encourages applicants who may benefit from treatment to seek it, and the Committee views such treatment as a positive factor in evaluating an application. As indicated in the Rules, all proceedings conducted pursuant to the Rules and Regulations are confidential.

On occasion, a license may be denied when an applicant's ability to function is impaired in a manner that indicates that the applicant is currently unfit to practice law as a foreign legal consultant at the time the licensing decision is made, or when the applicant demonstrates a lack of candor and/or credibility by his or her response. Protection of the public that will receive legal services underlies the licensing responsibilities assigned to the Committee. Furthermore, each applicant is responsible for demonstrating that he or she possesses the qualifications necessary to practice law as a foreign legal consultant. Your response may include information as to why, in your opinion or that of your treatment provider, your condition will not affect your ability to practice law as a foreign legal consultant in a competent and professional manner.

The Connecticut Bar Examining Committee does not, by its questions, seek information that is characterized as situational counseling, such as stress counseling, domestic counseling, and grief counseling. Generally, the Committee does not view these types of counseling as germane to the issue of whether an applicant is qualified to practice law as a foreign legal consultant.
