- Two hundred inquiries were received as a result of Shery introducing the SAFE Program to the CT Nurses' Association via an email campaign
- Eighteen applications have been received for the Fall SAFE Training Program in September

 Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for qualified individuals, who are already practicing SAFEs, to complete the *Train the Trainer* course and to enlist additional trainers to fill the increasing need for education in the hospitals, so the training materials are standardized across the state.

Committee members discussed issues related to the preceptor requirements in the state of Connecticut versus the requirements in most other states.

Committee members were encouraged to develop ideas to make the SAFE Program a statewide Response and Training Program.
