

The <u>Connecticut Supreme Court's</u> second term will begin on Tuesday, Oct. 9, and end on Friday, Oct. 19, 2018.

As part of its <u>"On Circuit" program</u>, the Supreme Court will hear arguments in two cases at Trinity College in Hartford on Wednesday, Oct. 17. All other arguments will be heard at the <u>Supreme Court</u>, <u>231 Capitol</u> Ave., Hartford.

The 2018-2019 court year has eight terms, and the assignment for days and case summaries are posted on the Judicial Branch's website before each term begins.
