Quick Response Code Available on Jury Summons

Jurors may now use their mobile devices to automatically link via a Quick Response Code to the [Jury Administration](#) webpage, where they can confirm or postpone their service online, as well as email Jury Administration. The “QR Code” is on the left side of the jury summons, top right corner.

QR codes store information in the form of a two-dimensional square barcode, and a QR reader application is necessary to detect the code. Users may download a QR reader application through his or her mobile device’s marketplace or store, and several such apps are available.

“In our continuing efforts to enhance our means of communication through the use of technology, Jury Administration is pleased to announce this new feature to the jury summons. We hope that this new QR code will provide a quick and easy way for potential jurors to access jury information,” Jury Administrator Esther Harris said.

A handbook and a reminder notice with directions to the court will be mailed to you about one week before the date you are to come to court. The handbook has general information about juror service.

You will be required to serve for at least one day. If you are selected for a trial, you must serve until the end of the trial.

You may ask to postpone your jury service to another day within 10 months of the court date above by going on-line to www.jud.ct.gov/jury/answer.htm or filling out the right side of this form. The Jury Administrator will schedule you on the date you request, if possible. If the date you request is not available, you will be scheduled for a date as close as possible to your requested date. If you do not specify a date, one will be selected for you.

If you can come to court on your court date, you can confirm on-line. Please visit our website at www.jud.ct.gov/jury/answer.htm. You may also fill out and return the right side of this form (Confirmation Form to Jury Administration). If you claim one of the disqualifications on the Confirmation Form, please check the appropriate box and send in the supporting documents, if any are requested.

The Judicial Branch complies with the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA). If you need a reasonable accommodation in accordance with the ADA, contact Jury Administration.
