

The <u>Connecticut Supreme Court</u> will start the fifth term of the 2017-2018 court year on Tuesday, Jan. 16, and the term will end on Thursday, Jan. 18. All cases will be argued at the <u>Supreme Court courtroom</u>, 231 Capitol Ave., <u>Hartford</u>.
