PER CURIAM. The defendant, Christine Stanton, appeals from an order of the trial court granting her postjudgment motion for modification of the parties' separation agreement. On appeal, the defendant claims that the court erred in reducing the child support obligations of the plaintiff, Christopher Stanton, despite the finding of the court that the plaintiff's income had substantially increased.
