1. The plaintiff (landlord) and defendant (deceased tenant/occupant) agreed that the defendant (deceased tenant/occupant) would lease (rent) on a monthly basis or for a term, the premises (rental property) named above.

3. The right of the defendant (deceased tenant/occupant) to occupy the premises terminated upon his/her death.
4. The plaintiff (landlord) obtained from the probate court having jurisdiction over the premises a certificate indicating that the landlord has complied with the notice and inventory and filing requirements contained in Section 47a-11d of the Connecticut General Statutes.
5. The probate court certificate has been filed with this application.
6. Based on the above, the plaintiff (landlord) asks this court for judgment for immediate possession of the premises.
