Section 53a-32(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended by P.A. 10-43 section 20 states, in part: “Any Probation Officer may arrest any defendant on probation without a warrant or may deputize any other officer with power to arrest to do so by giving such other officer a written statement setting forth that the defendant has, in the judgment of the probation officer, violated the conditions of the defendant's probation. Such written statement, delivered with the defendant by the arresting officer to the official in charge of any correctional center or other place of detention, shall be sufficient warrant for the detention of the defendant.”

When my probation was transferred to Connecticut I agreed:

- 1) To comply with the terms and conditions of probation placed on me.
- 2) That if I did not comply with the terms and conditions of my probation it would be considered a violation and that I may be returned to the sending state.
- 3) That I would not resist or fight any effort by any state to return me to the sending state and **I agreed to waive any right I may have to extradition. I waived this right freely, voluntarily and intelligently.**

The sending state will take one of the following actions regarding the violations of your conditions noted above:

- 1) Inform Connecticut that a warrant has been issued for your arrest and that the intent is to return you to the sending state. The sending state will have 30 days to pick you up from the holding facility; or
- 2) Instruct Connecticut to release you from custody and continue supervision. It is possible that additional conditions and/or graduated sanctions will be imposed by the sending or receiving state. If the sending state orders your release, you **MUST** immediately report to your Probation Officer.
