Notice to Probationer Transferred to Technical Violation Unit:

As of the date above, you have been transferred to the Technical Violation Unit. You have been transferred to this unit because you have not followed one or more conditions of your probation.

We are giving you a chance to successfully finish your probation instead of seeking a violation of probation.

If you continue not to follow the conditions of your probation, we may ask the court to issue a warrant for your arrest and require you to go to jail for the rest of your sentence.

You must now follow the Standard and Special Conditions of your Probation *and* the following conditions:

- (1) Report to the Probation Officer at least once a week unless your probation officer gives you different instructions.
- (2) Follow any treatment or other kind of referral, or both, made by the Probation Officer.
- (3) The following conditions ordered by your probation officer:
