1. If defendant's period of probation ends, and defendant has not paid the full amount of restitution ordered by the court, complete this form for each victim to whom the defendant still owes restitution.

Under section 53a-28a of the Connecticut General Statutes, you have the right to ask the civil court to enforce the rest of this restitution order in the same manner as a judgment in a civil case. There is no fee to file an action in civil court to enforce a restitution order.

If you would like to file a civil action to enforce the rest of this restitution order, you the court will need a copy of the criminal court's Order of Probation requiring the defendant to pay restitution or the criminal court's Order of Restitution for this case, and an affidavit from Adult Probation Services that tells the court what the terms of the restitution order were, the way that the defendant was required to pay that restitution, the amount that the defendant has paid toward that order, and the balance that is left to be paid.
