The Court has ordered that you take part in a Victim Impact Panel (VIP) through Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD).

- You must register at the VIP location during the registration period that starts 45 minutes before the VIP starts. You cannot register before that time.
- You must pay MADD \$75.00 using a money order or certified bank check, payable to MADD, on the day of the panel. (*No cash or personal checks.*)
- You must bring a photo I.D. to be allowed into the VIP.
- You will not be admitted into the VIP after it starts. Do not be late.
- You must go to and finish the VIP that is scheduled next in your area, and that VIP is listed below. When you finish the VIP, MADD will give you a certificate saying that you finished the VIP.
- You must give Pretrial Services a copy of the certificate saying that you finished the VIP. It should be mailed to CSSD, Pretrial Services at the Address of Court listed above or faxed to the Pretrial Services office fax number listed above.
- **The court may not dismiss your case if you do not send Pretrial Services proof that you went to the VIP and finished it.**
- You *cannot* take part in an online victim impact panel under this court order.
