Payment must be made by **cash, certified check** or **money order** before the due date shown above. Make Certified Check or Money Order payable to: "Clerk of Superior Court". Return this notice with payment to the address of court shown above. Do not mail cash.

Failure to comply may result in court action, including, but not limited to:

1. Grievance Committee Notification (*If an attorney is the maker of the check*)
2. Suspension of Motor Vehicle or Boating License (*Where section 14-140 or section 15-154 of the Connecticut General Statutes is applicable*)
3. Issuance of a Rearrest Warrant in the above case (*If the case is a criminal matter*)
4. Issuance of an Arrest Warrant for Violation of General Statutes section 53a-128, Issuing A Bad Check
