Notice Regarding Hearing

A hearing on the record has been scheduled for this matter on the date and time shown on the attached order.

If you or your attorney do not appear on the date and time shown on the attached order, the court **may** make a decision on this matter based on the papers filed by the applicant without scheduling a hearing at which witnesses can testify and evidence will be presented.

If you want to appear at this court hearing, you or your attorney must file an Appearance (form JD-CL-12) with the court before the hearing.

At the hearing, the court will first conduct a conference with you or your attorney and the applicant or the applicant's attorney. The purpose of the conference is to attempt to resolve issues and to schedule a hearing for this matter, if it is required, at which witnesses can testify and evidence can be presented. If such a hearing is required, the court will schedule it, usually within two weeks of the date shown on the attached order.
