Return Schedule for Administrative Appeal

1. Within seven days of receipt of request/file, assigned law clerk will contact judge to notify judge of the assignment and to establish a date for the first conference.

3. Second Conference with Judge:
Judge to determine at this meeting whether supervisory review is wanted.
