Instructions to SEO:

1. Confirm that the obligor has qualified for SSI disability and has no other income or assets that can satisfy the support order.
2. Send this Notice to the custodial party/obligee.
3. If custodial party/obligee objects to SES filing a § 46b-215 (m) motion to modify, do not file the motion.
4. If custodial party/obligee does not object to SES filing a § 46b-215 (m) motion to modify within 15 calendar days of their receipt of this Notice, file the Motion to Modify Support Order – SSI, form JD-FM-293.

Notice

Support Enforcement Services (SES) has determined that the obligor in this case has qualified for disability benefits under the federal Supplemental Security Income Program (SSI).

And, after a diligent search, SES did not find any other income or assets that the obligor could use to pay the support order listed above.

Therefore, SES will be filing a motion asking the court to modify (change) the child support order listed above to **\$0** without a hearing, unless you tell SES that you object to (disagree with) this motion. If the Court grants the motion to modify the support order, it will not remove or change any balance that the obligor currently owes you. It will only change the amount of current support the obligor owes you going forward to **\$0**.

If you do not tell SES that you object to the motion to modify the support order to **\$0**, the Court may:

- Grant this motion without holding a hearing
- Deny this motion without holding a hearing; or
- Order a Court hearing on this motion

If you do tell SES that you object to the motion, SES will not file this type of motion to modify. But, SES or the obligor may still file a regular motion to modify the support order, which may require you to go to court, and which may still result in a **\$0** support order.

If you want to tell SES that you object to the filing of this motion to change the support order to **\$0**, you **must**:

- Sign the "Objection" section below; and
- Return the signed form to SES at the address below no later than 15 calendar days after you get this notice:

If you do not want to object to SES filing this motion, you do not need to do anything to respond to this notice. If SES does not hear from you within 15 days of you getting this Notice, SES will just go forward with filing the motion to modify.
