If you do not make payments in accordance with this order, you will receive in the mail an order from the clerk to file your answer to the complaint. If you do not file your answer within four days from the date the clerk's order was mailed, judgment will be entered for the plaintiff. If you do file your answer within four days from the date the clerk's order was mailed, the clerk will set this matter down for hearing not less than three nor more than seven days after your answer and the plaintiff's reply, if any, are filed.
