1. Read PREA Notification below to each detainee listed.
2. Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, or Judicial Marshal Sergeant in the absence of Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, must write in new arrestees, habeas or others who may require notice, as needed.
3. Instruct each detainee to acknowledge notice by their signature.
4. Record notification in Court Management System (CMS).
5. Number pages if multiple pages are used.
6. Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, or Judicial Marshal Sergeant in the absence of the Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, must review and sign this form by the end of the day.
7. Retain this form for inspection and audit.

The Connecticut Judicial Branch has a zero tolerance policy for all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment in its facilities. This includes conduct between detainees and conduct between detainees and Judicial Branch staff/contractors/volunteers.

If you have been subjected to or become subject to any form of sexual abuse or sexual harassment while in the custody of the Judicial Branch, you can report it, either orally or in writing, to any Judicial Marshal or Judicial Branch employee. You can also report it to the Connecticut State Police.

The Connecticut Judicial Branch also has a zero tolerance policy for any form of retaliation against those who report an incident of sexual abuse or sexual harassment or cooperate in a sexual abuse or sexual harassment investigation.

Any individual who is found in violation of these policies will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action and/or will be referred to the Connecticut State Police for criminal investigation.
