

## PRISON RAPE ELIMINATION ACT (PREA) SCREENING

## Instructions

1. Screen detainees for risk sexual victimization.
2. Document risk, if any, and actions taken to mitigate risk, in Cellblock Log.
3. Note badge number of Judicial Marshal doing each screening.
4. Number pages if multiple pages are used.
5. Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, or Judicial Marshal Sergeant in the absence of the Judicial Marshal Lieutenant, must review and sign this form by the end of the day.
6. Retain this form for inspection and audit.

## **Criteria to consider while screening for risk of sexual victimization**

### The nature of the detainee's offense

The age of the detainee (17-24 or 55 and older)

#### The physical build and appearance of the detainee

Is the detainee substantially smaller in size than the other detainees?

Is the detainee effeminate?

### The detainee's incarceration history

Is this the detainee's first incarceration?

Does the detainee's have a history of sexual activity while incarcerated?

Does the detainee's have a history of protective custody while incarcerated?

Whether the detainee is gay/lesbian/bisexual/transgender/intersex

Whether the detainee has a mental, physical or developmental disability  
Whether the detainee has a history of being sexually abused or being

sexually abusive toward other detainees

Whether the detainee states they feel they are at risk of being abused

All inclusive and a detainees may not exhibit any of the traits listed.

**It is important to note that the above list is NOT all inclusive and a detainee may not exhibit any of the traits listed above prior to an incident of victimization.**
