| The nature of the detainee's offense | The detainee's incarceration history |
| The age of the detainee (17-24 or 55 and older) | Is this the detainee's first incarceration? |
| The physical build and appearance of the detainee | Does the detainee's have a history of sexual activity while incarcerated? |
| Is the detainee substantially smaller in size than the other detainees? | Does the detainee's have a history of protective custody while incarcerated? |
| Is the detainee effeminate? | Whether the detainee is gay/lesbian/bisexual/transgender/intersex |
| | Whether the detainee has a mental, physical or developmental disability |
| | Whether the detainee has a history of being sexually abused or being sexually abusive toward other detainees |
| | Whether the detainee states they feel they are at risk of being abused |
